


Unlocking Chart view on your AERA 795

Step 1. Please click on the following link and follow the online instructions to download and install the Garmin communicator plugin. <http://software.garmin.com/en-US/gcp.html>


Step 2. Please click on the following link. <https://fly.garmin.com/fly-garmin/>

Step 3. Create a flygarmin account. Click on “Create One” to create a new account. If you already have a flygarmin account, log in and skip to Step 5.

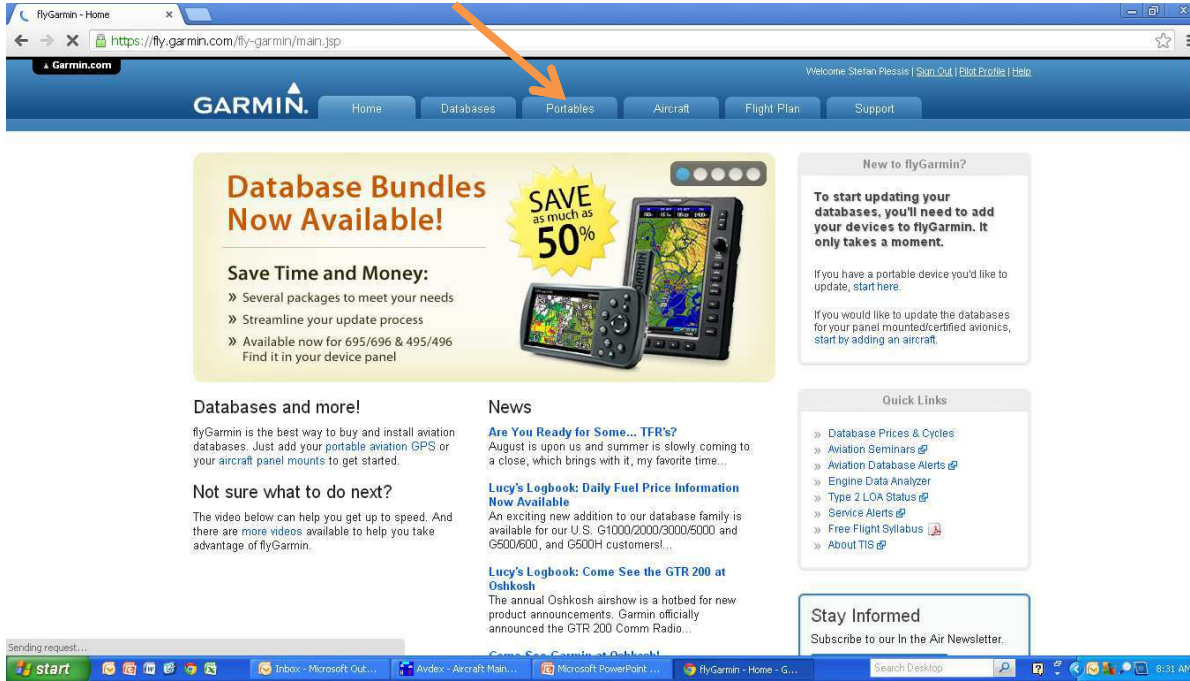

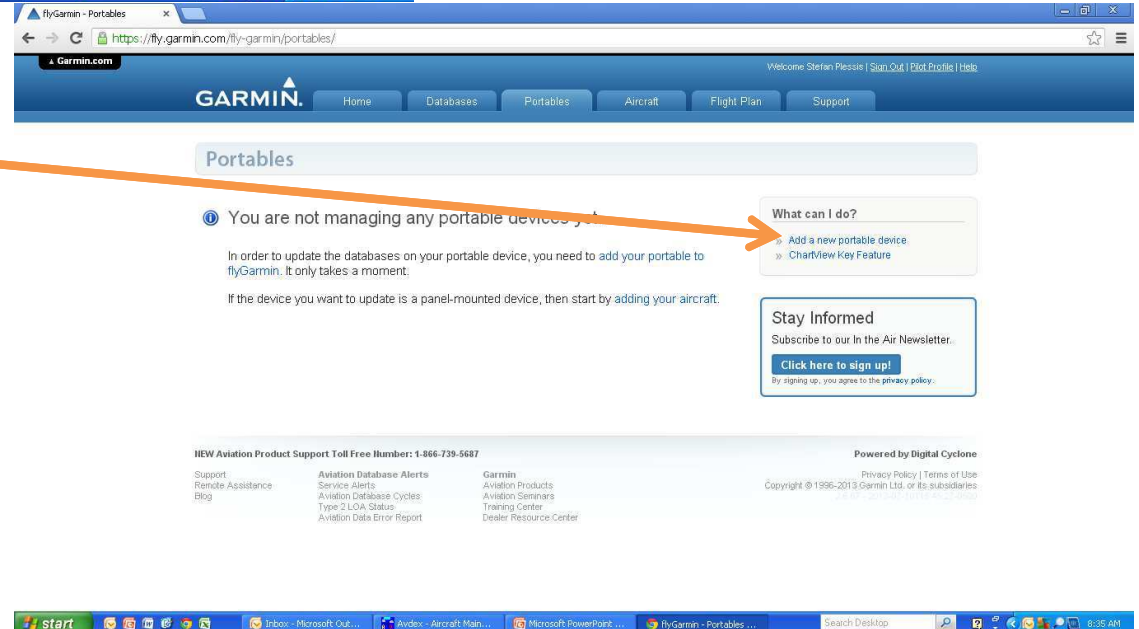

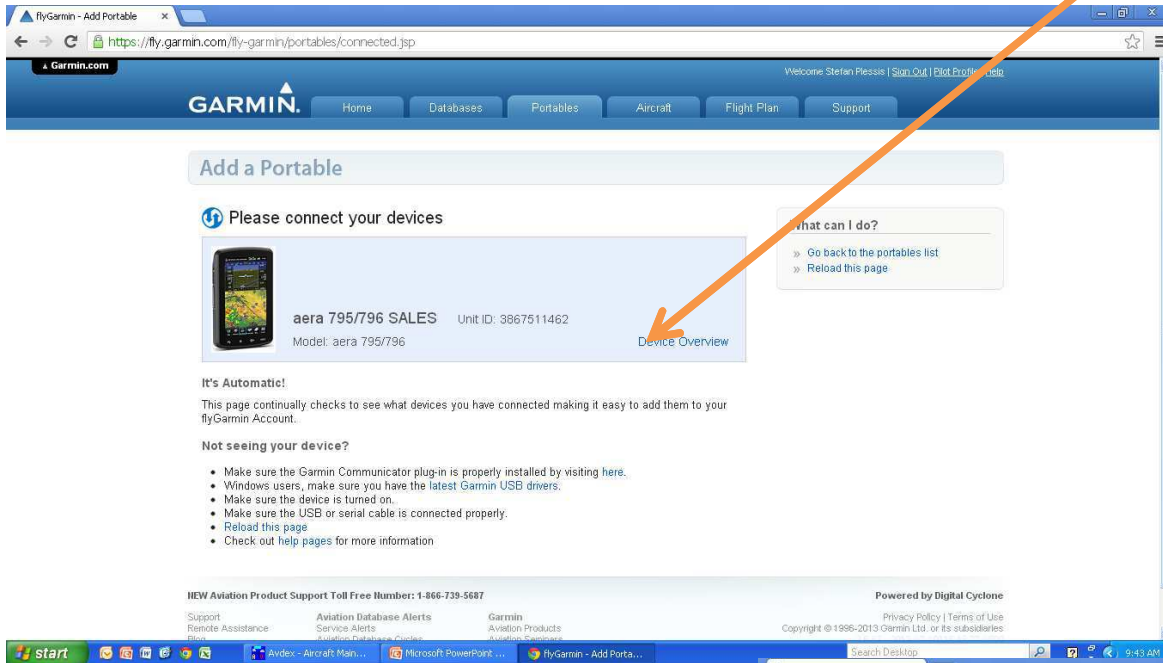
Step 5. Click on "Portable".



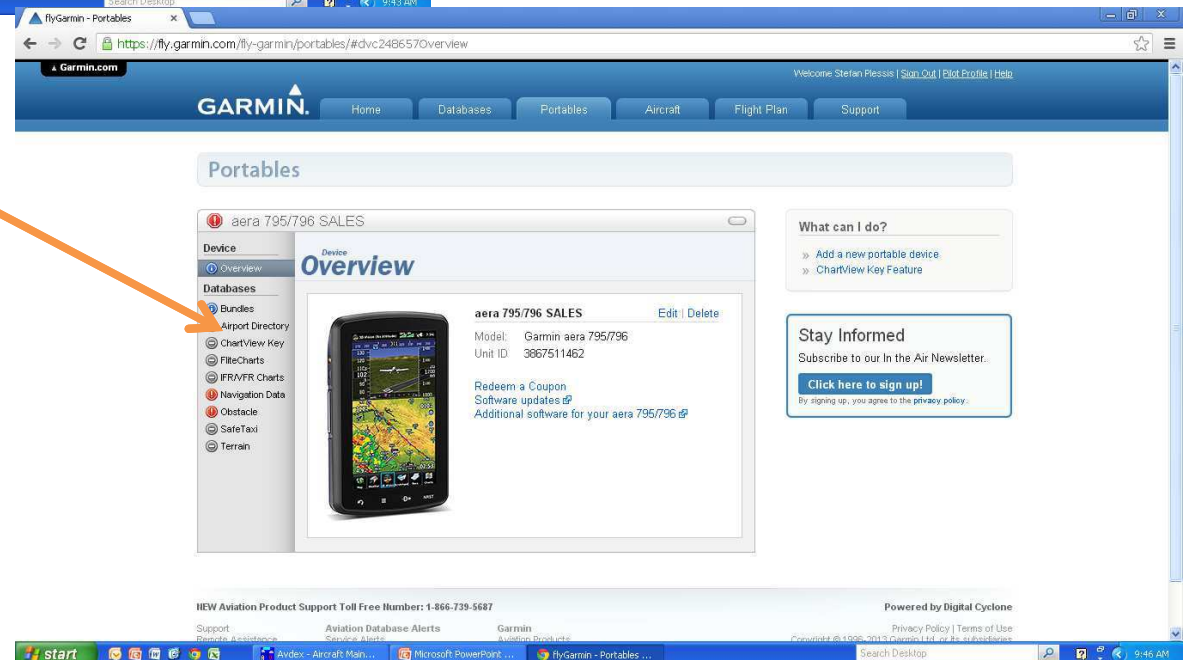
Step 6. Click on "Add a new portable device".



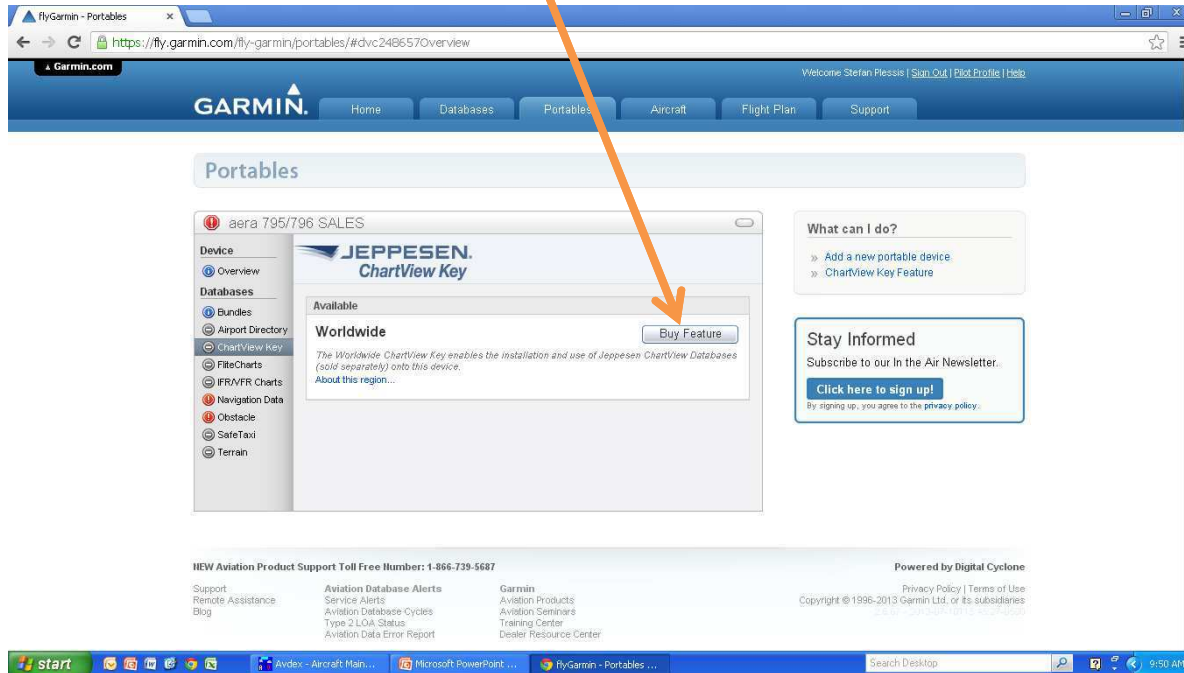
Step 7. Once flygarmin picks up your Aera 795 click on "Add device".
